

ENTRIES FOR 24TH TROFEO ANDREA MARGUTTI AT LONATO TO OPEN ON THE NEXT 21ST OF JANUARY

THE TOP INTERNATIONAL KART RACING EVENT, SCHEDULED FROM MARCH 8 TO 10, IS BACK WITH A FOUR-CLASS LINE-UP OF KF, KFJ, KZ2, 60 MINI AND 20.000€ PRIZE MONEY



Registrations for the 24th edition of the prestigious **Trofeo Andrea Margutti** will be opened from the next **21st of January**, with the last day available being Sunday, February the 10th. The event will take place between the **8th** and the **10th of March** at the **South Garda Karting** circuit at **Lonato**, close to **Brescia**.

Four classes will be allowed on-track: **KF**, **KFJ**, **KZ2** and **60 Mini**, running on a 3-day schedule. Scrutineering will be starting on Friday, as well as free practice. The official practice sessions will go underway on Saturday, March the 9th, followed by timed qualifications and by the heat races. The finals will be held on Sunday, March the 10th, after the repechage and pre-final heats.

Last season it was Felice Tiene to cruise to win in KF2 for CRG, the same team of KZ2 winner Fabian Federer. Martin Kodric was

the winner in KF3 with Ricky Flinn Motorsport, while American Logan Sergeant held the Ward Racing banner high in 60 Mini.
